## 2009 FALL EXHIBITION

MAA Members will exhibit their paintings this fall at 'Bethesda Hospital in their Gallery Café located at 559 Capitol Blvd. St. Paul 55103. (Located one block north of the Minnesota State Capital.) Exhibit will start on Monday September 28<sup>th</sup>, and end on Monday November 30<sup>th</sup>. There is room for 40 to 60 average to large paintings. Let us see what you have been working on this summer.

## **ENTRY FEE:**

## \$15.00 for one entry, \$25.00 for two entries.

As a member you may enter two paintings. This is also a good time to renew your membership. Make payments to: MAA and include with the form below. <u>To renew your membership enclose separate payment for \$25.00 individual, or \$40.00 per family.</u>

## **DROP OFF:**

The drop off will take place on Monday Sept. 28<sup>th</sup> at 9:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. You will drive up to the Como Street door and drop off your paintings. This is not the '*Main Entrance*'. I will be there to receive the paintings and have the Artists sign in. The Artists will not have to get out of their cars at the drop off. If they would like to come in they are welcome to, and they can park in the adjoining parking ramp and join us.

### **GUIDELINES or RULES:**

Artwork must be original work only. No digitals or copies. Work must be framed and wired for hanging. Drawings, prints and watercolors must be under glass, Plexiglas or varnished. No art previously entered in MAA shows will be accepted. Artwork must remain for the duration of the show.

## ART INSURANCE;

Each artist is responsible for insuring their own work.

**SELLING AGENT:** Bethesda Hospital will act as the selling agent for the Artists. The volunteer office will accept payment for the painting and forward the payment to the Artist. The Artist is responsible for payment of a 30% commission fee to the Bethesda Art Program by the end of the exhibit. The Artist is also responsible to pay any required sales tax.
